



TRAINING IN

Forensic Psychotherapy (P4)

This five year specialist registrar programme is designed to provide a training in forensic psychotherapy in which the core model is psychoanalytically based. It trains consultants who will obtain dual CCSTs in forensic psychiatry and psychotherapy. It enables you to develop forensic skills at suitable linked institutions and receive advanced training in the application of psychoanalytic principles to a variety of clinical and related settings in the forensic field.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Psychiatric trainees who have at least completed the MRCPsych examination and who may have previous experience at SpR level in either general or forensic psychiatry.

PERSONAL ANALYSIS

Applicants are required to be in personal analysis.

TIME COMMITMENT

5 years full-time commitment, integrated throughout, with time at Three Bridges Regional Secure Unit at Ealing Hospital.
