This conference brings together experienced speakers presenting different standpoints on their work in the field of family violence, in conversation with each other, and offers the opportunity for dialogue and reflection.

In this challenging area of work, it is important to bring together different perspectives and a variety of approaches to help address the complexities. The day will include ideas developed in work with men, women, children, families and communities. The aim is to generate new ideas to support thinking and practice, and new initiatives.

Martine Groen is a Clinical Psychologist and Psychotherapist in the Netherlands, who has specialised in the effects of violence and trauma in families. She has published work on prostitution, shame and violence and is the co-author of *Intimate Warfare* (Karnac Books 2008).

Judith Milner and **Thelma Singleton** work with the Domestic Violence Programme in Kirklees, and have developed a solution-focused approach. Judith Milner is co-author of *Working with Violence: Policies and Practices in Risk Assessment and Management* (Palgrave 2007).

Jasvinder Sanghera is Director and founder of Karma Nirvana, an Asian project working with issues of forced marriage and 'honour'-based violence. She is the author of *Shame*.

Shazia Qayum is the Young Persons' Project Worker at Karma Nirvana who experienced a forced marriage herself.

Reenee Singh is a Systemic Family Psychotherapist at the Tavistock Clinic and Director of the Centre for Cross-Cultural Studies at the Institute of Family Therapy.

Charlotte Burck, Consultant Systemic Psychotherapist and **Ellie Kavner**, Head of Systemic Psychotherapy, both at the Tavistock Clinic, have been developing family therapy for mothers and children post-violence.

Liz Dillon is a Drama and Movement Therapist and Project Coordinator for the Family Support Project, Solace Women's Aid in London, delivering a domestic violence parallel programme for mothers and children developed in Canada.

Mark Rivett is a Senior Lecturer at Bristol University and a Systemic Psychotherapist. He has managed a Domestic Violence project for the NSPCC in Cardiff providing clinical services and multi-agency involvement. He is the co-author of *Working with Men in Health and Social Care* (Sage 2007), and the editor elect of the Journal of Family Therapy.
